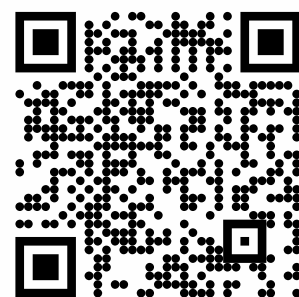

How to reach:

By Air: Nearest Airport from RSU Lavad Campus is Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel International Airport, Ahmedabad, which is 40km away from the RSU Lavad campus. Other nearby International Airport is Chatrapati Shivaji International Airport, Mumbai (550 km) and domestic airport is Baroda (137 km).

By Rail: Nearest Railway Station from RSU Lavad Campus is Ahmedabad Railway Station, which is 40km away from the RSU Lavad campus. Other nearby major Railway Station is Baroda (137km).

By Road: There are two routes from Ahmedabad. 1) Ahmedabad - Naroda Patiya - Dehgam - Lavad. 2) Ahmedabad - Airport Road - Nana Chiloda - Dehgam - Lavad. One can also come from route Gandhinagar - Chiloda - Dehgam - Lavad.
