Eligibility Criteria for the post of Assistant Professor (Information Technology and Electronic / Telecommunication – Sr. No. 1 & 5)

Essential qualifications:

- I. First Class Master's Degree in the appropriate branch of Engineering (Engg.) & Technology (Tech.)
- II. Fluency in English and working knowledge of Gujarati or Hindi

Desirable Qualification:

- I. Teaching, research industrial and / or professional experience in the areas of cyber-security / cyber forensic from reputed organization
- II. Papers presented / published at Conferences and / or in refereed journals
- III. PhD Degree in accordance with UGC Regulations

Eligibility Criteria for the post of Assistant Professor (Law, Forensic Science & Political Science/Social Science – Sr. No. 2, 3 & 4)

Essential qualifications:

- I. A Good academic record with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade wherever grading system is followed) at the Master's Degree level in relevant subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from a foreign university accredited by UGC.
- II. Cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) or SLET for lecturers / Asst. Prof. conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC.
- III. Fluency in English, basic Knowledge of Computer and working knowledge of Gujarati or Hindi

Notwithstanding anything contained in clauses (I) and (II), candidates, who are, or have been awarded a Ph. D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET/SET, for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent position.

NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted.

Desirable Qualification:

- I. Teaching, research industrial and / or professional experience from reputed organization
- II. Papers presented / published at Conferences and / or in refereed journals
- III. PhD Degree in accordance with UGC Regulations

Eligibility Criteria for the post of Assistant Professor (Cyber Forensics – Sr. No. 6)

Essential Qualification:

- I. First Class Master's Degree in the appropriate branch of Engineering (Engg.) & Technology (Tech)
- II. A Good academic record
- III. Knowledge of Cyber Forensics, Cyber Security, Networking, Server etc.
- IV. Fluency in English and working knowledge of Gujarati or Hindi

Desirable Qualification:

- I. Teaching, research industrial and / or professional experience in the areas of cyber-security / cyber forensics from reputed organization
- II. Papers presented / published at Conferences and / or in refereed journals
- III. PhD Degree in accordance with UGC Regulations
- IV. Certificates such as CISSP, SANS, CEH, CHFI or Diploma in relevant field from recognized Institute.
- V. Cleared national level tests such as GATE / NET / CSIR-NET / SET

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

- Knowledge of subject matter and course content pertinent to Cyber Security and Cyber Forensics programs.
- Expertise in tools (such as EnCase, Tools, Volatility, Magnet Forensics, Autopsy, Wireshark, Nessus, Nmap etc.)
- Core knowledge of different operating systems like Windows, Linux, Kali Linux, Mac etc.
- Knowledge of Cyber Crime and Cyber Security trends, evidence collection from different digital media, different digital evidence analysis techniques, RAM capturing and analysis, Fundamentals of Malware analysis, Network Security, Log analysis techniques, Networking, Server etc.
- Enterprise security design and implementation skills.

Eligibility Criteria for the post of Assistant Professor (Forensic Photography – Sr. No. 7)

Essential Qualification:

- I. Good academic record with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the Master's Degree level in Forensic Science or Physics from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.
- II. Cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET.
- III. Knowledge of Photography and/or Videography
- IV. Fluency in English, basic Knowledge of Computer and working knowledge of Gujarati or Hindi

Notwithstanding anything contained in clauses (I) and (II), candidates, who are, or have been awarded a Ph. D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009, shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions

NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted.

Desirable Qualification:

- I. Certificate / Diploma course in Photography and/or Videography
- II. Teaching, research, industrial and / or professional experience in the areas of Forensic Science / Photography / Videography from reputed organization
- III. PhD Degree in accordance with UGC Regulations
- IV. Papers presented / published at Conferences and / or in refereed journals

General Instructions :

1. The prescribed qualifications and experience shall be the minimum, and the mere fact that a candidate possesses the same shall not entitle him/her for interview. The University shall have the right to restrict the number of candidates to be interviewed to a reasonable level on the basis of better or higher qualifications and experience than the minimum prescribed, and on the basis of other relevant factors.
2. The University reserves the right not to fill in any of the positions or to fill the positions at lower levels without assigning any reason.
3. Canvassing or influencing in any form on behalf of any candidate will disqualify such candidate. University reserves the right to take appropriate action against such candidate.
4. All the candidates are expected to download from RSU website, duly fill and bring along with them the "Brief Profile Form" for the interview. The Form should be neatly and legibly filled or typed preferably in at least 12 font size.
5. The complete Bio-data along with all self attested copy of all relevant certificates and documents should be brought at the time of interview.
6. Candidates who will reach after reporting time will not be allowed to appear in the interview.
7. Read carefully teaching/research requirements of the relevant discipline and apply only if you have requisite qualifications and experience.
8. The University shall have the right to:
 - a. relax any of the qualifications/experience at its discretion;
 - b. draw/ reserve panel(s) against the possible vacancies in the near future;
9. Experience and qualification will be reckoned as on the date of interview.
10. No TA / DA shall be paid to the candidates for attending the interview.
11. In case of any inadvertent mistake in the process of selection which may come to notice at any stage even after the issue of appointment letter, the University reserves the right to modify / withdraw / cancel any communication made to the candidates.

12. In case of any dispute / ambiguity that may occur in the process of selection, the decision of the University shall be final and binding.
13. No correspondence will be entertained from candidates regarding postal delays, conduct and result of interview and reasons for not being called for interview.
14. The period of time spent by the candidates to acquire M.Phil and/or full time Ph.D Degree shall not be considered as teaching/research experience to be claimed for appointment to the teaching positions.
15. Candidates applying for the post of Assistant Professor shall submit a certificate from the concerned University to the effect that the Ph.D degree obtained by him is in the compliance with the UGC (Minimum standards and procedure for award of M.Phil (Ph.D degree) Regulations 2009/2016 along with the Ordinance of University at the time of interview.
16. The University campus would shift to its new campus at Lavad (Dist. Gandhinagar) in near future. Selected candidate is required to work at any of the campuses of the University.
17. The appointment shall be governed by the rules and regulations of the University.
