**Eligibility Criteria for the post of Assistant Professor
(Criminology, Police Administration, Forensic Science, Forensic
Psychology, Law, Political Science/Social Science & Statistics –
Sr. No. 1,2,6,7,8,9 & 10)**

Essential qualifications:

- A Master's degree with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale wherever the grading system is followed) in a concerned/relevant/allied subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.
- Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC or the CSIR, or a similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET or who are or have been awarded a Ph. D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be exempted from NET/SLET/SET :

Provided, the candidates registered for the Ph.D. programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/Bye-laws/Regulations of the Institution awarding the degree and such Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions :-

- a) The Ph.D. degree of the candidate has been awarded in a regular mode;
- b) The Ph.D. thesis has been evaluated by at least two external examiners;
- c) An open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate has been conducted;
- d) The Candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work, out of which at least one is in a refereed journal;
- e) The candidate has presented at least two papers based on his/her Ph.D work in conferences/seminars sponsored/funded/supported by the UGC / ICSSR/ CSIR or any similar agency.

The fulfilment of these conditions is to be certified by the Registrar or the Dean (Academic Affairs) of the University concerned.

Note: NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET.

Desirable Qualification:

- I. Teaching, Research and / or professional experience from reputed organization
- II. Papers presented / published at Conferences and / or in refereed journals
- III. Proficiency in English and working knowledge of Gujarati and Hindi.

Eligibility Criteria for the post of Assistant Professor (Information Technology – Sr. No. 3)

Essential qualifications:

- I. B. E. / B. Tech. / B. S. and M. E. / M. Tech. / M. S. or Integrated M. Tech. in relevant branch with first class or equivalent in any one of the degrees.

Desirable Qualification:

- I. Teaching, Research and / or professional experience in the areas of cyber-security / cyber forensic from reputed organization
- II. Papers presented / published at Conferences and / or in refereed journals
- III. PhD Degree in accordance with UGC Regulations
- IV. Fluency in English and working knowledge of Gujarati or Hindi
- V. Cleared national level tests such as GATE / NET / CSIR-NET /SET

Eligibility Criteria for the post of Assistant Professor (Cyber Forensics – Sr. No. 4)

Essential Qualification:

- I. B. E. / B. Tech. / B. S. and M. E. / M. Tech. / M. S. or Integrated M. Tech. in relevant branch with first class or equivalent in any one of the degrees.
- II. Knowledge of Cyber Forensics, Cyber Security, Networking, Server etc.

Desirable Qualification:

- I. Teaching, Research and / or professional experience in the areas of cyber-security / cyber forensics from reputed organization
- II. Papers presented / published at Conferences and / or in refereed journals
- III. PhD Degree in accordance with UGC Regulations
- IV. Certificates such as CISSP, SANS, CEH, CHFI or Diploma in relevant field from recognized Institute.
- V. Cleared national level tests such as GATE / NET / CSIR-NET / SET
- VI. Fluency in English and working knowledge of Gujarati or Hindi

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

- Knowledge of subject matter and course content pertinent to Cyber Security and Cyber Forensics programs.
- Expertise in tools (such as EnCase, Tools, Volatility, Magnet Forensics, Autopsy, Wireshark, Nessus, Nmap etc.)
- Core knowledge of different operating systems like Windows, Linux, Kali Linux, Mac etc.
- Knowledge of Cyber Crime and Cyber Security trends, evidence collection from different digital media, different digital evidence analysis techniques, RAM capturing and analysis, Fundamentals of Malware analysis, Network Security, Log analysis techniques, Networking, Server etc.
- Enterprise security design and implementation skills.

Eligibility Criteria for the post of Teaching Cum Research Associate (Information Technology – Sr. No. 5)

Essential qualifications:

- A M.Sc / M.Tech degree with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale wherever the grading system is followed) in Information Security / Cyber Security / Digital Forensics subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.

Desirable Qualification:

- Teaching, Research and / or professional experience from reputed organization
- Papers presented / published at Conferences and / or in refereed journals
- Proficiency in English and working knowledge of Gujarati and Hindi.
- National Eligibility Test (NET) in accordance with UGC Regulations or the CSIR, or a similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET.

Eligibility Criteria for the post of Soft Skills Trainer – Sr. No. 11)**Essential qualifications:**

- A Master's degree with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale wherever the grading system is followed) in English/Journalism/Mass Communication subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.

Desirable Qualification:

- Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate should have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC or the CSIR, or a similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET.
- Teaching, Research and / or professional experience from reputed organization.
- Papers presented / published at Conferences and / or in refereed journals.
- Proficiency in English and working knowledge of Gujarati and Hindi.
- Ph.D Degree in accordance with UGC Regulations.
- Experience imparting Personality Development / Soft Skills.

General Instructions:

1. The prescribed qualifications and/or experience shall be the minimum, and the mere fact that a candidate possesses the same shall not entitle him/her for interview. The Raksha Shakti University shall have the right to restrict the number of candidates to be interviewed to a reasonable level based on better or higher qualifications and experience than the minimum prescribed.
2. The Raksha Shakti University reserves the right not to fill in any of the positions or to fill the positions at lower levels without assigning any reason. It also reserves right to fill number of posts as per requirement of Raksha Shakti University not as per advertisement.
3. Canvassing or influencing in any form on behalf of any candidate will disqualify such candidate. Raksha Shakti University reserves the right to take appropriate action against such candidate.
4. All the candidates are expected to download from RSU website, duly fill and bring along with them the "Brief Profile Form" for the interview. The Form should be neatly and legibly filled or typed preferably in at least 12 font size.
5. The complete Bio-data along with all self-attested copy of all relevant certificates and documents should be brought at the time of interview.
6. Candidates who will reach after reporting time will not be allowed to appear in the interview.
7. Read carefully teaching/research requirements of the relevant discipline and apply only if you have requisite qualifications and experience.
8. The Raksha Shakti University shall have the right to:
 - a. relax any of the qualifications/experience at its discretion;
 - b. draw/ reserve panel(s) against the possible vacancies in the near future;
9. Experience and qualification will be reckoned as on the date of interview.
10. No TA / DA shall be paid to the candidates for attending the interview.
11. In case of any inadvertent mistake in the process of selection, which may come to notice at any stage even after the issue of appointment letter, the Raksha Shakti University reserves the right to modify / withdraw / cancel any communication, made to the candidates.

12. In case of any dispute / ambiguity that may occur in the process of selection, the decision of the Raksha Shakti University shall be final and binding.
13. No correspondence will be entertained from candidates regarding postal delays, conduct and result of interview and reasons for not being called for interview.
14. The period of time spent by the candidates to acquire M.Phil and/or Ph.D Degree shall not be considered as teaching/research experience to be claimed for appointment to the teaching positions.
15. Candidates applying for the post of Assistant Professor shall submit a certificate from the concerned Raksha Shakti University to the effect that the Ph.D degree obtained by him is in the compliance with the UGC (Minimum standards and procedure for award of M.Phil (Ph.D degree) Regulations 2009/2016 along with the Ordinance of Raksha Shakti University at the time of interview.
16. The appointment shall be governed by the rules and regulations of the Raksha Shakti University.
